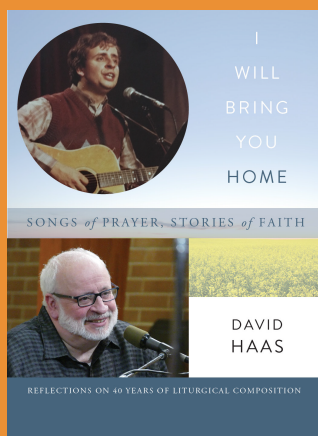


Daily Living Reminder
