The Language of Sin

There is a range of Biblical language about sin:

To be perverse: sin as a twisted or distorted condition, a deviation from the true standard.

To do evil: sin as general wickedness and immorality.

To revolt, rebel: sin as offence against the rights of others, especially of God.

To lie: sin as denying reality and showing inconsistency between one's word and deed.

To miss the mark: sin as fault or failure, a missing of the mark.

To be foolish: sin as a stupid course of action because of its disastrous consequences.

St Paul speaks of all the baptised as the one body of Christ, each part contributing to the whole. If one part is weak, the whole body is effected (1Cor 12:12-26).

Paul also speaks of the effects of sin within a person as a kind of slavery (Rom 7:14-15).

The church also describes sin as grave or venial. Grave sin involves serious matter, full knowledge and deliberate consent. Venial sin wounds but does not destroy the relationship (CCC#18154-1864).

Call to Conversion in Christ

The people of God are constantly called to turn back to their God. This call to conversion is notably part of the prophets' work. In preparing for Christ, John the Baptist renews this prophetic call (eg Mark 1:1-8; Lk 3: 1-18). Jesus begins his ministry by announcing the reign of God as a time of repentance and conversion. He came to call sinners to repentance (Lk 5:32). God rejoices when anyone repents (Lk 15:7, 10, 22-24). It is appropriate to seek God's forgiveness and to forgive one another (Matt 6:12). Conversion is liberation from past burdens and a new appreciation of life. Zaccheus in Luke, the Samaritan woman in John, and Saul in Acts, are examples of these. The church continues this call to conversion in Christ.

True and False Guilt

Feeling guilty is not necessarily a good measure of true guilt. Such feelings may come from childhood conditioning to do what one thinks is expected by authority figures or society. This is not true moral guilt. True conscience may evoke a feeling of unease which needs to be heeded so as to examine if it is a call to acknowledge sin and grow in the Christian life. Spiritual guidance may be needed to discern this.

Formation of Conscience

The church teaches that human beings are called to act according to conscience, a God-given ability at the core of a person to love and choose good and avoid evil (GS#16). Conscience judges particular choices, approving the good and condemning the sinful. It can be blunted or distorted, and may err. Conscience needs continuing formation. (See *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, nn 1783-1794). Liturgy, particularly the liturgy of the word, is an important context for being regularly formed in good human and christian values. Being open to God's word is an important part of our spiritual fitness. For those prepared to hear the word, the seed will fall on good soil (Mk 4: 1-9). If we are hearers and doers of the word we build on a solid foundation (Matt 7: 24-27). God's word echoes in our hearts, shaping our conscience.

The Sacrament of Penance

Broken and strained relationships are sad and painful experiences which are all too common. When we realise that something we have done, or not done, has disturbed our relationships with other people, we need to restore and renew those relationships. It is necessary to acknowledge our offence, ask for and receive forgiveness before there is peace once more. The same is true of our relationship with God, in and through the church. Through our rich tradition of sacrament and ritual, we are able to experience the boundless mercy of God and be restored to communion with one another in the communion of the Trinity.

Since all liturgy is an action of the whole body of Christ, celebrating the sacraments is essentially communal. But the individualism in society often undermines our sense of the communal in the church. We may need to be reminded that the sacrament of penance is not just about personal reconciliation with God but about being reconciled to God through reconciliation with Christ's body, the church.
